Reishi (靈芝) mushrooms are woody fungi also known in Japan as mannentake (万年茸) which grow from late July to October. These interesting mushrooms come in several colors (red, black, blue, etc.) and are distinctively hard, woody, and fibrous. In Japanese culture, reishi is a sacred symbol of health, spiritual peace, and longevity. That is thanks to the fact that it is an adaptogen – a natural substance believed to help the body cope with stress. Moreover, reishi is prized for its antioxidative and anti-inflammatory properties. Therefore, it is no surprise that it is used widely in



Japan, specifically in traditional medicine to soothe the mind and strengthen the immune system, and, of course, premium J-beauty skincare to reduce skin redness, soothe inflammation, and repair the skin barrier. The Japanese skincare brands infuse reishi extracts into anti-aging serums, lotions, and masks.

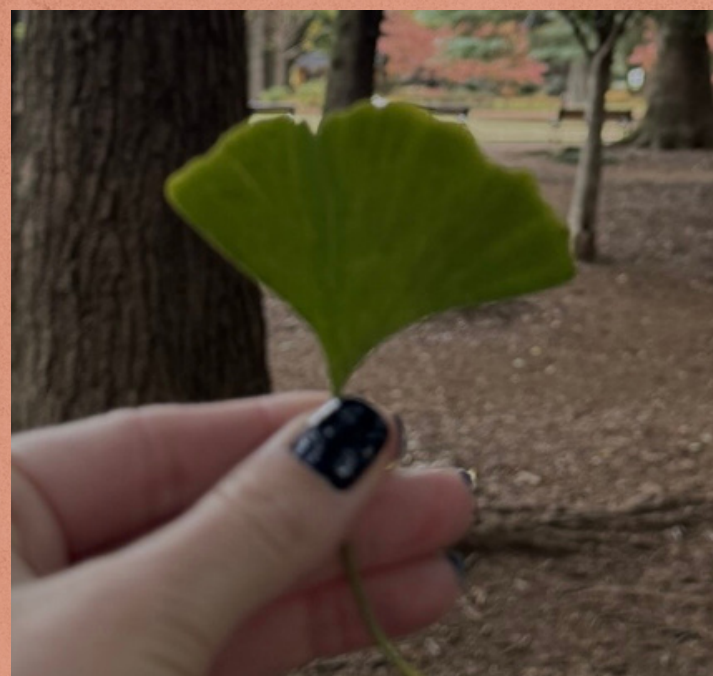
